Ken Gamble was appointed as Executive Chairman of Internet Fraud Watchdog Ltd (IFW) in June 2007. Under Mr. Gamble's leadership, IFW personnel and resources have reduced internet fraud and detected fake websites, particularly in the sports and entertainment ticketing industries, preventing major frauds from occurring before international sporting matches. IFW also detects and prevents satellite television piracy for some of the major Conditional Access providers and broadcasters in Europe using highly skilled cybercrime investigators and engineers.

Mr. Gamble has a distinguished 22 year career as a private investigator and in 2009 was appointed as the Australian Chapter of the International Association of Cybercrime Prevention (L'Association Internationale de Lutte Contre la Cybercriminalité (A.I.L.C.C.) based in France.

Mr. Gamble's cases have been featured, and his expertise highlighted, on numerous top rating News & Current Affairs shows in Australia, the United Kingdom and the USA. He currently serves as the Managing Director of his own investigative agency, Gamble Investigations International Ltd ("GII") based in Brussels, with overseas offices in Sydney, Los Angeles and London. GII services include worldwide investigations, corporate intelligence and protective security operations.
